The City of Milton-Freewater is announcing the start of construction work to replace the heating and cooling system, windows and lighting at City Hall, 722 S. Main Street beginning April 28, 2010. Work is projected to be completed no later than August 15, 2010.

We are aiming to do our best to ensure uninterrupted customer service during construction. Various access points and parking areas of City Hall may be closed and/or re-routed to include the library book drop, ballot box and payment drop box. We will ensure access to the Police Department is available. Customers wishing to use our payment drop boxes may continue to do so uninterrupted by using the one located at Baker Boyer Bank and/or across from the Post Office. A library book drop is located next to the library entrance off SW 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
