

NEW BUS SCHEDULE COMING SOON

WE ARE SO EXCITED -- BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2010, THE CITY WILL EXTEND THEIR FIXED-ROUTE BUS SYSTEM TO FIVE DAYS EACH WEEK!!

Patrons have been asking for several years to extend our fixed-route bus program to five days every week. Our City Manager, Linda Hall, and our City Council all unanimously agree this is a good change. To accommodate this change into our current and upcoming budget, we have worked through our route, eliminating a fourth trip each day. But we have not left you out there with no way back! For several years we have been coordinating our route with other bus routes in the area and our new route has also been coordinated with area bus vendors.
