


WE ARE OUT OF THE FLOOD ZONE!

I am obligated to report that if people wish to continue paying flood insurance on their homes and buildings, they are still able to. However, if you do not wish to pay for flood insurance, you will no longer be required to by your mortgage lender.

If any question arises about proof that your home does not require flood insurance, please contact our planning department at (541) 938-8234 (City Planner Gina Hartzheim) or (541) 938-8235 (Planning Assistant Sharame Marlatt) and ask for a copy of your property's updated and revised flood risk map. This should be all you need to verify that your home no longer requires flood insurance to be mandatorily purchased.

DOG LICENSING

2014 tags available November 1st

Help us to help you get your dog back!

Dog licenses will be available for purchase on November 1st for your canine pals!

City code **REQUIRES** dog licensing for **ALL** dogs over six (6) months of age.

License tags help identify your animal in the case they wander off. If your dog has a license tag, they are much more likely to be returned to you rather than impounded.

To obtain your new license fill out the form below, get proof of valid rabies vaccination from your veterinarian and remit your fee of \$35 for unaltered and \$10 for altered dogs at the Police Department or mail them in to us. Fees after March 1st incur an additional \$10 charge.

Do You Have Your 2014 Business License?

If you have a business location within the City or if you are doing business in the City, you will need a City Business License. The fee is \$35.00 and is due by January 1st of each year.


Leaves piled or bagged in the street near the curb will be picked up without charge by the City of Milton-Freewater crews starting Monday, November 18, 2013 through Friday, December 13, 2013. Please do not put lawn clippings, branches or other materials on the street or fees will be assessed. This event is to clean up **LEAVES ONLY**.

Leaves will be picked up according to which "ZONE" your residence is located in. Dates for each "ZONE" are as follows:

- Zone 1 11/18/13-11/22/13 SW portion of town from S. Main west and south of Broadway
- Zone 2 11/25/13-11/29/13 SE portion of town from S. Main east and south of Broadway
- Zone 3 12/02/13-12/06/13 NE portion of town from N. Elizabeth east and north of Broadway
- Zone 4 12/09/13-12/13/13 NW portion of town from N. Elizabeth west and north of Broadway

TREE TRIMMING

The City of Milton-Freewater has an aggressive tree trimming policy with the intent of public safety and service reliability.

This past summer and fall we experienced a few windstorms that caused tree damage and power outages throughout our valley and region. Our public works crews were kept busy removing dangerous hanging limbs and cleaning up debris that was a hazard to the public. Our electric department responded to numerous down limbs on secondary house services but only had a few isolated outages and all customers had power restored within four (4) hours. Much of this was because of our winter tree trimming program. Winter tree trimming will be starting in December and continuing through March.

We encourage you to keep your trees and bushes trimmed, especially if you would like it done a specific way. Our goal is to make your City electric system safe with as few service interruptions as possible.



CONSERVATION CORNER

Current Residential Weatherization Programs

- Heat Pumps-Rebates range from \$500 to \$1.400.
- Windows-Rebates are \$3 per square foot of window area.
- Insulation-Rebates are available up to \$0.50 per square foot.
- Duct Sealing-Rebate is \$400 per system.

Weatherization Tip: Close your foundation vents during late fall and open them in early spring for added protection to help keep your water pipes from freezing. For more information please contact Pat Didion at Ext. 8237.
