- Position:** Public Works LABORER – Seasonal
- Salary:** Salary range \$17.75 to \$21.49 hourly
- Duties:** Works under the supervision of the Public Works Superintendent. Performs a variety of manual, unskilled and semi-skilled tasks in the general construction and maintenance of city water, sewer, street, parks and solid waste facilities; operates automotive and power equipment. Does related work as required.
- Qualifications:** Ability to follow oral and written instructions and act upon them accordingly. Ability to safely operate all equipment and follow safety rules; some knowledge of appropriate tools, equipment, methods, materials and procedures used in maintenance or construction work. Ability to perform strenuous manual tasks such as lifting and carrying up to 65 pounds of material frequently on normal shift, and to withstand exposure to variable weather conditions. Ability to safely operate light automotive equipment and power-driven hand tools as required. Must be willing to work weekends and occasional holidays.
- Experience and Training:** Requires some experience in general maintenance and construction work. Any other satisfactory equivalent combination of experience and training which ensures the ability to perform the work may substitute for the above. Graduation from high school or the equivalent GED certificate is required. Possession of or the ability to secure possession of a valid driver's license.
- Method of Selection:** Evaluation of candidate's background and application forms. Only those applicants who appear best qualified as determined by a screening committee will be interviewed. However, the City of Milton-Freewater reserves the right to not fill this position, reject all applications, reopen the position or make a direct appointment.
