Recycling update!!!

The City of Milton-Freewater has been in the recycling business for six months! During this time we have established two drop off depots for our citizens to bring their recyclables to. We cannot thank our citizens enough for being open-minded and quite receptive of the new program.

While the recycling market is at an all-time low when it comes to redemption of recyclables we continue to save space in our landfill thanks to all those participating in the new program. Many recycling providers have thrown in the towel on curbside co-mingled collection or increased their rates substantially just to pay to get rid of their recyclables, not us. We have specifically set our program up to keep the rates low and yet continue to offer a recycling program.

In the first six months we have recycled 84.16 tons of materials! Thank you Milton-Freewater citizens for all you support of this program!!

Have an old hot water heater, bed frame, kitchen range, washer, dryer, etc. you need to get rid of? Haul it yourself to the County Road depot during operating hours and get rid of it for free. Yes --- zero, zipo, zilch! This is something new we are offering and is a savings over you storing and then hauling it to the landfill during one of our clean up events or having us haul it away from your property for a fee of \$26.20 per item. The program is user- friendly and only takes you a moment to drop off your items. Stop in and check it out!

Event Rules:

- Each Customer is allowed up to 800 lbs with their ticket.
- Each Customer is allowed up to 4 tires.
- **TIRES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE RIM**—additional waste will be charged to your account.
- No E-waste accepted—(televisions, computers, etc)
- All loads must be covered & secured. Fee may be charged on loads not secured or tarped.
- Customers must have a ticket and current utility bill.
- Event is for city refuse paying customers **ONLY!**
- One ticket will be issued per customer. No replacement tickets will be issued
- New refuse customers may be issued a ticket by contacting the Public Works Department at 541-938-8270 between the hours of 7am-12 noon & 1pm-4pm., Monday—Friday.

2018 Leaf Collection

Leaves piled or bagged in the street near the curb will be picked up without charge by the City of Milton-Freewater crews starting Tuesday, November 13th thru Friday, December 7th. Leaves picked up according to your residence zone (see below —zone map & further information is on the City's website at www.mfcity.com).

(S. Main west and south of Broadway)

Zone 2 11/19/18-11/21/18 SE portion of town
(S. Main east and south of Broadway)

Zone 3 11/26/18-11/30/18 NE portion of town
(N. Elizabeth east and north of Broadway)

Zone 4 12/03/18-12/07/18 NW portion of town
(N. Elizabeth west and north of Broadway)
