In response to the recent Covid-19 pandemic, the City of Milton-Freewater is offering utility bill assistance for small businesses of less than 25 employees grant to aid our business community affected by state and federal mandated pandemic restrictions. The grant will be a credit for the City of Milton-Freewater utilities (sewer, water, solid waste and electric) charges on account for a total maximum of \$1,000 per business. Criteria are as follows:

- For businesses with 25 or less employees which are economically impacted by the Covid-19 restrictions and closures.
