

The City of Milton-Freewater will be re-opening City Hall, the Library, and Public Works buildings to the public effective Monday, June 7th.

There will be a few safety protocols in place to protect the safety of our customers and employees as we re-open and get back to "normal".

Masks will be required and social distancing will be observed.

For City Hall (722 South Main) and Public Works Offices (501 Lamb Street):

If customers anticipate their business taking over 15 minutes per visit, we are asking that they call for an appointment to be sure that we do not have too many customers in our lobby or offices at one time. Appointments should be made by calling the department for which your business is related. Please see our web site (MFcity.com) for a directory list.

If paying a utility bill, a court fine, getting a quick license or permit, or some other straight-forward and quick business, no appointment will be required.

For finger-printing services at the Police Department, an appointment will be required. Please call (541) 938-5511.

For the Library (8 SW 8th Ave) (541 938-8247) Patrons will be limited to maximum of 24 people at any one time, and will be limited to a one hour visit.

Aquatic Center (2nd and DeHaven Street) (541 938-9166) The Joe Humbert Family Aquatic Center is open effective June 3 at 4:00 p.m. Occupancy will be limited to 72 patrons at one time.
