FOR USE OF THE MILTON-FREEWATER FAMILY AQUATIC CENTER


WHEREAS, it has been ascertained by the Milton-Freewater City Council that the existing rates are in need of revision, and

¹Seniors are citizens ages 60 and over.

²Disabled patron requires a doctor's certification of disability.

³Caregiver Pass is for individuals who provide direct supervision to those who cannot be in the facility unsupervised due to age or condition. (i.e. grandparent, babysitter, or caregiver for individual with disability.) The pass is only valid when providing such direct supervision.

⁴A family is five individuals or less (i.e. two parents and up to three children that reside in the same household). Additional members may be added for \$15.00 per additional member.

⁵Each session is two weeks, Monday through Friday, weather permitting. If a family pass is obtained by a family of more than five members, lesson costs for the first two members is \$30.00 each and then reduced to \$15.00 for additional members thereafter.

⁶Rentals have a required two hour minimum. Available hours are 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., Monday-Friday and 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday, with the possibility of additional times during morning hours, depending upon other uses.
