Engineering Services for Substation Upgrades

The City of Milton-Freewater invites Statements of Qualifications for professional engineering services related to electric substation resiliency upgrades. Services may include design, engineering, and construction support for substation transformer replacement, switching improvements, voltage regulator upgrades, control building improvements, and related infrastructure.

This project is anticipated to utilize Oregon Department of Energy Grid Resilience Grant funding and may be subject to applicable federal requirements, including Davis-Bacon prevailing wage and Build America, Buy America provisions.

Engineering Services for Substation Upgrades

The City of Milton-Freewater, Oregon invites Statements of Qualifications for professional engineering services associated with a Substation Upgrade Project. The project may include design and engineering support for power transformer replacement, 69 kV switching improvements, bus modifications, voltage regulator upgrades, control building improvements, and related electric system resiliency infrastructure.

Firms submitting Statements of Qualifications must comply with all applicable Oregon Revised Statutes and federal, state, and local requirements, including public contracting, Workers' Compensation, Industrial Accident Insurance, Income Tax Withholding, and Social Security requirements. Because this project is partially funded through the Oregon Department of Energy Grid Resilience Grant Program, the selected firm and any subcontractors may also be subject to applicable federal grant requirements, including Davis-Bacon prevailing wage requirements and Build America, Buy America provisions.

The City reserves the right to select the firm deemed most qualified based on experience, technical expertise, project understanding, and ability to successfully deliver the proposed services, and to negotiate a final scope and fee with the selected firm.
