THIS BUSINESS, IN COOPERATION WITH THE MILTON-FREEWATER POLICE DEPARTMENT, CONSIDERS OFFICERS OF THE MILTON-FREEWATER POLICE DEPARTMENT "PERSONS IN CHARGE" OF THIS PROPERTY AS DEFINED IN ORS 164.205 (5). INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE IN OR UPON THESE PREMISES AFTER NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION MAY BE ARRESTED FOR CRIMINAL TRESPASS, OR MAY BE EJECTED OR REMOVED FROM THE PROPERTY AND EXCLUDED FROM ENTERING OR REMAINING IN OR UPON THESE PREMISES INDEFINITELY.
