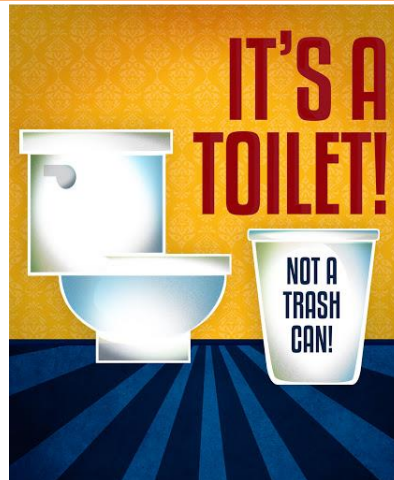

Pee, Poo, and (Toilet) Paper

Just because the package says flushable doesn't mean it's true. Many items marketed as disposable and/or flushable do not degrade like toilet paper, and they wind up clogging pipes, getting stuck in pumps, and cause messy sewer backups.

REMINDER – Never flush the following items. Toss them in the trash instead.

Baby/Facial/Cleaning Wipes
Sanitary Napkins
Tampons
Medication
Hair
Dental Floss
Cotton Swabs/Balls
Rags and Towels
Rubber items (like Latex gloves)
Fat, Cooking Oil, Grease
