

CITY OF MILTON-FREEWATER RECYCLING CUSTOMERS

Effective after March 2, 2018 we will no

longer offer curbside recycling.

RECYCLING RATES WILL REMAIN AT \$4.15 PER MONTH.

Our NEW recycling program will require you to self-haul your recyclables to our drop off depot locations .

Why: Due to increased costs primarily for labor and decreased marketability for the sale of recyclables as well as the termination of our service contract for curbside recycling we have gone back to the drawing board to figure out WHAT NEXT? What can we afford to do without increasing fees? What must we do to comply with our permit?

The City of Milton-Freewater owns and operates our own solid waste utility. We are permitted to do so by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). A requirement of that permit is to have a recycling program. In order to have a program, we must have funding to operate the program. While the recycling fee is mandatory, participation is optional BUT highly recommended and it is also the environmentally responsible thing to do. We strongly suggest you recycle right and recycle responsibly by following the guidelines on what we take, how to prepare it, sort it and haul it to one of our drop off depots. We pay the DEQ for solid waste tonnage put in our landfill. If our landfill tonnages go up, fees go up. When fees go up rates must go up as well.

To have a more efficient drop off experience please have all items sorted separately before you arrive. Only bring the accepted items as outlined on the back. TOGETHER WE CAN RECYCLE RIGHT AND RECYCLE RESPONSIBLY!
