BRING IT TO OUR COUNTY RD DEPOT FOR NO ADDITIONAL FEE!

The City of Milton-Freewater owns and operates our own solid waste utility. We are permitted to do so by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). **A requirement of that permit is to have a recycling program.** In order to have a program, we must have funding to operate the program. While the recycling fee is mandatory, participation is optional BUT highly recommended and it is also the environmentally responsible thing to do. We strongly suggest you recycle right and recycle responsibly by following the guidelines on what we take, how to prepare it, sort it and haul it to one of our drop off depots. We pay the DEQ for solid waste tonnage put in our landfill. If our landfill tonnages go up, fees go up. When fees go up rates must go up as well.

BEFORE YOU GO

1. Have all items sorted and properly prepared before you arrive.
2. Only bring the accepted items as outlined on the back.

Don't pay to get rid of your old one. Haul it away yourself for free to our County Rd recycling depot.

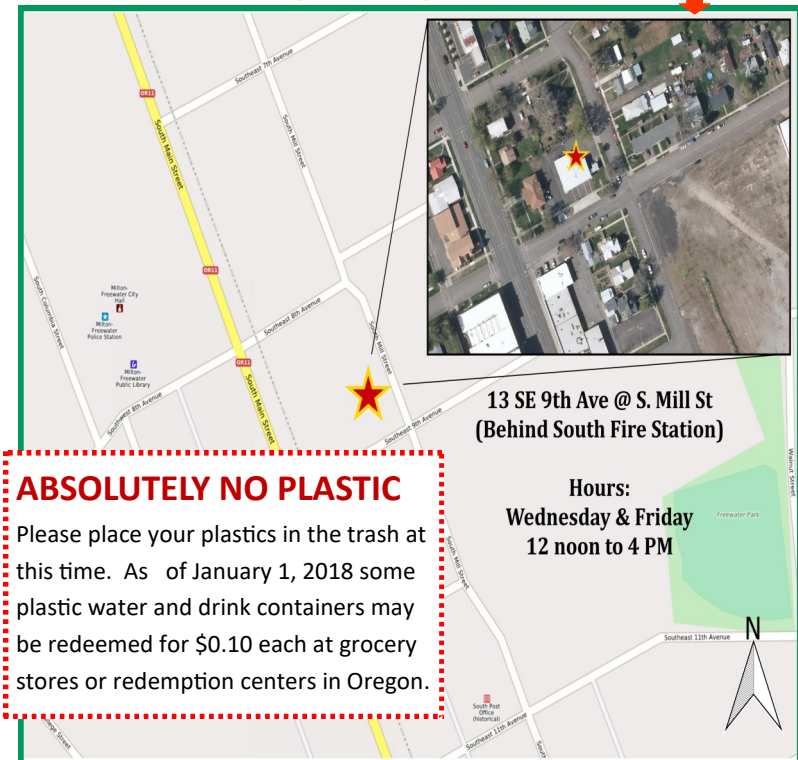
