

# CLEANUP 2019

City refuse paying customers receive a ticket in their utility bill for ONE (1) free load at the City's landfill during the event.

Ticket must be presented at the site along with your most recent utility bill.

**April 26<sup>th</sup>**

7:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. & 12 p.m. – 6 p.m.

**April 27<sup>th</sup>**

7:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. & 12 p.m. – 5 p.m.

Tickets are mailed in your utility bill.

Be watching in your utility bill for your ticket.

**Cycle 1** (i.e. account number is 111.2222.33) Bills to be mailed 4/9

**Cycle 2** (i.e. account number is 222.3333.44) Bills to be mailed 4/16

**Cycle 3** (i.e. account number is 333.4444.55) Bills to be mailed 3/19

**Cycle 4** (i.e. account number is 444.5555.66) Bills to be mailed 3/26

MAXIMUM LIMITS:

- ◆ 800 pounds total. Weight in excess may be assessed additional fees.
- ◆ Maximum 4 passenger tires. Tires must be removed from rims—no exceptions.
- ◆ Loads must be covered or tarped to avoid additional fees.

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- ◆ E-waste—televisions and computers (monitors & hard drives).
- ◆ Hazardous waste—chemicals, batteries (including car batteries), medically generated waste, etc.

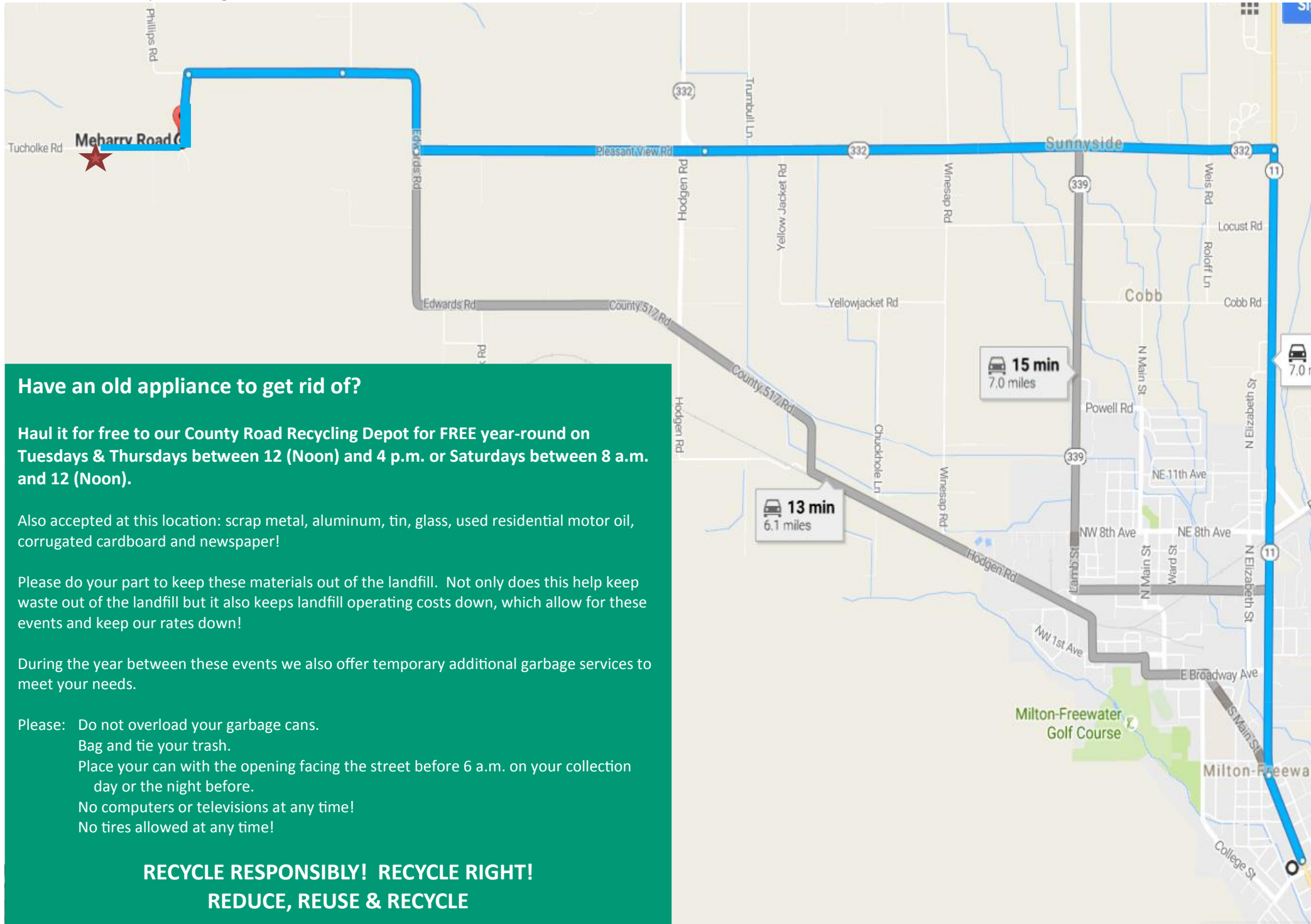

Haul it for free to our County Road Recycling Depot for FREE year-round on Tuesdays & Thursdays between 12 (Noon) and 4 p.m. or Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 12 (Noon).

Also accepted at this location: scrap metal, aluminum, tin, glass, used residential motor oil, corrugated cardboard and newspaper!

Please do your part to keep these materials out of the landfill. Not only does this help keep waste out of the landfill but it also keeps landfill operating costs down, which allow for these events and keep our rates down!

During the year between these events we also offer temporary additional garbage services to meet your needs.

- Please: Do not overload your garbage cans.
- Bag and tie your trash.
- Place your can with the opening facing the street before 6 a.m. on your collection day or the night before.
- No computers or televisions at any time!
- No tires allowed at any time!
