Trees must be placed along the curb within the dates shown above. Trees put out after the event may incur a fee for pick up.

Please do not put your tree in your garbage can.

Reminder – burn barrels are prohibited in the City Limits at all times.

<p>Used Cooking Oil</p> 	<p>Used household cooking oil. Clear sealed plastic containers.</p>	<p>YES ✓</p>	<p>NO X</p>
<p>Scrap Metal/Appliances</p> 	<p>Misc. Ferrous and Non-Ferrous Metal. Hot water heaters, ranges, dishwasher, washing machines, and other metal appliances. Self-haul - must haul and unload unassisted at site.</p>	<p>YES ✓</p>	<p>NO X</p>

<p>PLASTIC & STYROFOAM</p>	<p>Please dispose of Styrofoam and plastic in your trash can. We ask that you bag and tie all of your trash to keep it from blowing all over the valley.</p>		
<p>BATTERIES</p>	<p>Car batteries can be recycled where you purchase a new one.</p>		
<p>TELEVISIONS & COMPUTERS</p>	<p>Please E-cycle these items by hauling them to Humbert Refuse located at 54841 Hwy 332 – behind the drive in theater. There is a designated drop off site to unload them.</p>		
<p>TIRES</p>	<p>You can pay a fee at most any tire retailer to dispose of tires. The city also will collect them and put them in our recycling trailer for a fee. They cost us \$ to “recycle” them. They can also be brought to the landfill during our twice per year clean up events if you are a current city refuse service paying customer. See ticket/event info for rules.</p>		
<p>LITHIUM OR RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES</p>	<p>Please contact us for proper safe disposal of such items. DO NOT PUT THEM IN YOUR TRASH!</p>
