

Leaves piled or bagged in the street near the curb will be picked up without charge by the City of Milton-Freewater crews starting Monday, November 13, 2023 through Friday, December 8, 2023.

Leaves will be picked up according to which "ZONE" your residence is located in. See the map on back to help determine which "Zone" you are in. Please put your loose leaves out by the beginning of your week to allow for collection to occur during your designated week.

Dates for each "ZONE" are as follows:

Zone 1	11/13/23-11/17/23 SW portion of town
	(S. Main west and south of Broadway)
Zone 2	11/20/23-11/24/23 SE portion of town
	(S. Main east and south of Broadway)
Zone 3	11/27/23-12/01/23 NE portion of town
	(N. Elizabeth east and north of Broadway)

Zone 412/04/23-12/08/23NW portion of town(N. Elizabeth west and north of Broadway)

November 13th through December 8th

While we are quite familiar with the difficulty in predicting when the weather will change to trigger trees to lose their leaves, we do our best to schedule this event to allow adequate time for task completion and yet not tie up jointly used equipment for the next scheduled maintenance task ---which is typically tree trimming to clear branches from power lines. Zones have been established based off historic yields collected.

<u>Please do not put leaves out in the street after the above dates</u> <u>designated for your "ZONE" without checking with us first.</u>

Properties with extremely high volumes of leaves need to contact the Public Works Department prior to the event to discuss options for removal.

This event is to clean up **LEAVES ONLY**. Please do not put lawn clippings, branches or other materials on the streets or fees will be assessed. Mulched leaves will not be picked up unless they are bagged.
