#### **EVENT RULES:**

- \*Each customer is allowed up to 800 lbs. with their ticket.
- \*Each customer is allowed <u>up to 4</u> tires that do not exceed 24" diameter. ALL TIRES ARE TO BE REMOVED FROM THE RIM.
- \*No E-waste accepted (televisions, computers, printers, etc.)
- Please E-cycle them. It is FREE! Call for information.
- \* No automotive batteries allowed. Please recycle them. Most locations that sell new ones will take your old ones.
- \*All loads must be covered & secured fee may be charged on loads not secured or tarped.
- \*Customers are required to unload their own waste as directed by the site monitor.
- \*Customers must have utility ticket & current utility bill.
- \*Event is for city-refuse paying customers ONLY.
- \*One ticket will be issued per customer. Tickets will be mailed in your bill the month prior to the event. Paperless customers will see theirs at the beginning of October in their E-mail.
- \*Customers must have active services at the time tickets are sent out in order to participate in this event. If services are not active at that time, the next event will be in the spring. We also offer containers throughout the year for rent and don't forget to check out recycling opportunities.

Paperless bill

Tickets will be mailed in your next utility bill beginning the week shown below based on the first digit of your account number:

Paperless bill or E-statement customers' tickets will be E-mailed separate from your bill on October 1.

#### Need help finding the landfill?



#### We suggest that you load your waste according to type such as:

- Tires (up to limit, size and off rims)
- Appliances/Metal (ranges, refrigerators, washers, dryers, etc.) These items can also be hauled to the County Rd Recycle Depot during hours all year long for FREE!
- Brush (only natural materials cannot have paint, stain, nails, etc.)
- Garbage (regular household waste bag and tie all small items)

This will help expedite the time it takes for you to sort and unload at the site.

ABSOLUTELY NO hazardous waste, burn barrels, automotive batteries, tires mounted on wheels, televisions or computers.

# CONSERVE OUR RESOURCES AND LIMIT WASTE REDUCE, REUSE & RECYCLE WHEN POSSIBLE!

**DONATE!** Gently used items. Sometimes they are repurposed or used for parts to repair items rather than throwing something out and purchasing new.

**HAVE A YARD SALE!** Try to rehome gently used items that you no longer need and are in working order, you just don't need it any longer but can't bring yourself to throw it away.

**BICYCLES CAN BE DONATED!** Bring them to our County Rd depot and leave them along the fence by the metal bin and we will donate them to Danner Farms, a local youth mentoring program right here in Milton-Freewater.

Many local charities also take donations of clothing, blankets and other items all year round. Reach out and see if there is something you no longer need that they could use.

Local pet rescue centers sometimes also take donations of items such as blankets and bedding.
